The Woman's Rights Act

Sponsored By; Republican Originalist Caucus (usaroc.org); "Your legislator(s)"

AN ACT prohibiting biological males from competing in woman's and girl's only sports; to prohibit biological males from invading, occupying, or utilizing locker rooms and restrooms designated for the exclusive use of biological females; and otherwise invading, occupying, or utilizing any space designated for the exclusive use of biological females.

WHEREAS, the practice of creating exclusive places for Biological Woman and Girls to protect them from predatory behavior is long standing.

WHEREAS, Biological Males are on average larger and stronger and have inherent biological differences, therefore we have traditionally separated them from Biological Females when competing in sport. This was not only to foster fair competition but more importantly for the safety of our Women and Girls.

WHEREAS, it is our DUTY to protect our Women and Girls in their exclusive spaces from predatory behavior and the presence of the opposite sex, if not, why designate these spaces at all.

WHEREAS, Women and Girls have the RIGHT to hold and participate in Biologically Exclusive competitions.

WHEREAS, Women and Girls have the RIGHT to hold and participate in Biologically Exclusive events and spaces.

WHEREAS, Women and Girls have the RIGHT to be protected from predatory behavior in their Biologically Exclusive competitions, events, and spaces.

We The People Hereby;

Prohibit all Schools, Clubs, Leagues, and any other organization that holds competitions, events, or designates spaces for the Exclusive use of Biological Females; from admitting Biological Males as competitors or participants.

Prohibit all Schools, Clubs, Leagues, and any other organization that holds competitions, events, or designates spaces for the Exclusive use of Biological Males; from admitting Biological Females as competitors or participants.

Require all facilities that have restrooms or locker rooms to designate at minimum one exclusive facility for Biological Males and one exclusive facility for Biological Females with restroom or locker room capacity respecting the designated maximum capacity of the facility.

Screening for Biological Sex:

Biological sex is confirmed upon birth. Therefore, If the biological sex is not listed on birth certificates or if birth certificates have been altered to reflect gender identity rather than biological sex the athlete may not compete on biologically segregated sports teams, participate in biologically segregated events, or use biologically segregated locker rooms/ restrooms.

Notes:

None of the prohibitions in this act apply to or change the status of COED sports, competitions, or events. This Act encourages the creation of Divisions that accommodate athletes of all gender identities while preserving Biologically Segregated Divisions.
